Shawl of Muis - Week 4



USING 3 COLORS

The testers of my shawl asked me if there was a possibility to make the shawl in 3 colors. So I made a color chart with 2 options for the use of 3 colors. The differences are marked in red WEEK 4

Row	Stitch	Original	Option 1	Option 2
91-97	Hor. Stripe	1-2-1-2-1	1-2-1-2-1	1-2-1-2-1
98-99	Border	1	3	3
100	Border	2	3	3



REMINDER

Always start with an Increase, increase in front of the middle stitch and right after the middle stitch, and increase before the last stitch

Row 91 thru 97

Horizontal stripes

Row 91	TSS	color 1	CC in the return pass
Row 92	TPS	color 2	CC in the return pass
Row 93 Row 94	TSS TPS	color 1 color 2	CC in the return pass
Row 94 Row 95	TSS	color 2	CC in the return pass CC in the return pass
Row 96	TPS	color 2	CC in the return pass
Row 97	TSS	color 1	CC in the return pass






Row 98 thru 100

Cc in the last pull through of the return pass of row 97

Row 98 and 99 are made **in color 1** and Row 100 in color 2, because I did the frills in color 1. But you are free to change if you prefer that.

Openwork pattern



The pattern is made in the return pass. If you follow the step by step instruction it is easy, but don't skip a word.

Row 98

color 1 forward pass TSS

Return pass

step 1	pull through 1 loop
step 2	pull through 2 loops, (all increases will be done like this)
step 3	pull through 1 loop
step 4	pull through 4 loops,
step 5	pull through 1 loop TWICE
step 6	repeat step 4 and 5 until the increase before middle stitch,
step 7	pull through 2 loops 3 times
step 8	repeat step 4 and 5 until the increase before the last stitch
step 9	pull through 2 loops twice

ATTENTION

When you don't have 3 loops before the increase in front of the middle stitch, you pull through 2 loops until you have reached the middle stitch. Now you have to pull through 2 loops the same number as you did in front of the middle stitch. Go further with step 8.

(395 loops)

Row 99

color 1

Explanation TES Tunisian Extended stitch

The TES is based on the TSS, but it has an extra pull through 1 loop

step 1 pick up a stitch like a TSS

step 2 pull through

step 3 yarn over and pull through 1 loop on the hook

Forward pass

Start your row with a chain because the TES is higher.

TES in every stitch and on every chain

Return pass

step 1	pull through 1 loop
step 2	pull through 2 loops, (all increases will be done like this)
step 3	pull through 1 loop
step 4	pull through 4 loops,
step 5	pull through 1 loop TWICE
step 6	repeat step 4 and 5 until the increase before middle stitch,
step 7	pull through 2 loops 3 times
step 8	repeat step 4 and 5 until the increase before the last stitch
step 9	pull through 2 loops twice

ATTENTION

When you don't have 3 loops before the increase in front of the middle stitch, you pull through 2 loops until you have reached the middle stitch. Now you have to pull through 2 loops the same number as you did in front of the middle stitch. Go further with step 8.

(399 loops)

Row 100

color 2

Forward pass

Start your row with a chain because the TES is higher.

TES

Return pass

step 1	pull through 1 loop
step 2	pull through 2 loops, (all increases will be done like this)
step 3	pull through 1 loop
step 4	pull through 4 loops,
step 5	pull through 1 loop TWICE
step 6	repeat step 4 and 5 until the increase before middle stitch,
step 7	pull through 2 loops 3 times
step 8	repeat step 4 and 5 until the increase before the last sticth
step 9	pull through 2 loops twice

(403 loops)

Normally you make a closing pass in Tunisian crochet, but I decided to skip it here because of the tassels.

TIP

For the tassels you can use a cd/dvd cover or a book with a hard cover. Wrap your yarn around it, but do not overlap, cut the yarn and you have your tassels.

If the top of your shawl needs it you can make a border of a single crochet or whatever you like as a border.


